Chief Warrant Officer Three (CW3) Rebekah Sarah Stuyvesant, United States Army, Legal Administrator

CW3 Stuyvesant was born in Cottage Grove, Oregon in 1981 and lived in Oregon, California, Saudi Arabia, Austria, and New Mexico. CW3 Stuyvesant enlisted in the United States Army from Las Vegas, New Mexico on 28 September 1999. CW3 Stuyvesant attended Basic Training and Advanced Individual Training for MOS 27D, Paralegal Specialist, at Fort Jackson, South Carolina. Her initial assignment after graduation was with Headquarters and Headquarters Company (HHC), First Armored Division (1AD), Bad Kreuznach, Germany in April 2000. While assigned to HHC, 1AD, she deployed to Camp Bondsteel, Kosovo, in support of Operation of Joint Guardian/Task Force Falcon.

Other enlisted assignments include: Paralegal Specialist, Headquarters and Headquarters Battalion, Division Artillery, Fourth Infantry Division (Mechanized) (4ID(M)) and pre and post-trial NCO 4ID(M), Fort Hood, Texas; Pre-trial NCOIC and United States Army Garrison (Brigade) NCOIC, 15th Regimental Signal Brigade, Fort Gordon, Georgia; and Senior Army Paralegal NCO, Office of Military Commissions Defense, Washington, DC and Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.

Since her appointment, she has served in a variety of positions including: Legal Administrator, United States Army Intelligence Center of Excellence, Fort Huachuca, Arizona; Legal Administrator, United States Forces – Afghanistan, Kabul, Afghanistan; Legal Administrator, Office of the Army General Counsel, Washington, DC; Legal Administrator, United States Africa Command, Stuttgart, Germany; and currently she serves as the AXO to the Chief Warrant Officer of the Corps and as the 270A JAG Warrant Officer Career Manager.

CW3 Stuyvesant is a graduate of the Warrant Officer Candidate School, the Warrant Officer Basic Course, and the Warrant Officer Advanced Course. She holds a Master's in Business Administration from Liberty University, Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice from Troy University and an Associate of General Studies from Central Texas College.
